

Cookie Policy

An HTTP cookie or cookie is a special text, often encoded, sent by a server to a web browser and then sent back (unmodified) by the browser, each time it accesses that server.

Purposes of Cookies

Cookies mainly make it possible to recognize the user's terminal and present the content in a relevant way, adapted to the user's preferences. Cookies provide users with a pleasant browsing experience. They are also used in the preparation of aggregated anonymous statistics that help us understand how a user benefits from our web pages, allowing us to improve their structure and content, without allowing the user to be personally identified.

Types of Cookies

We use two types of cookies: session and persistent. Session cookies are temporary files that remain in the user's terminal until the end of the session or until the application is closed. Persistent cookies remain on the user's terminal for a period determined by the cookie parameters or until they are manually deleted by the user.

Cookies We Use

We use cookies for a variety of reasons. Unfortunately, in most cases, there are no industry standard options for disabling cookies without completely disabling the functionality and features you add to this site. It is recommended to keep all cookies. Our platform uses tracking tools to:

- Recognize new or old users;
- Improve our platform, or services.
- Serve interest-based advertising.
- Track browsing behaviors and activities over time on multiple devices or platforms.
- Understand the interests of visitors to our platform.

Blocking Cookies

Your browser may give you the ability to control cookies. How you do this depends on the type of cookie. Some browsers may be set to reject browser cookies. These pages also explain how you can manage and delete cookies.

Do Not Track Signals

Some browsers have "do not track" features that allow you to tell a website not to track you. These features are not all uniform. We are not currently responding to those signals. If you block cookies, certain functions on our Platform may not work.
